

A Note to Coaches, State IE, Glenwood High School

Welcome to Glenwood High School! We are very proud of our new building and are eager to show it off. If you have not already been here enjoying one of our athletic events, we think you will be impressed.

At first you may be confused by the building, but just remember: It is just a big circle. Go in either direction from any room and you will end up back at the beginning.

But because it is a new building we have several requests, requests that are not atypical of any host school for IE.

First of all, we ask that you be with your students as much as possible not only for their sake and support, but to help us around the building by being our surrogate “shushers”. The building is new—not sound proof and any help you can give monitoring the hallways would be greatly appreciated.

Second, we ask that you support our students by eating at the school rather than venturing to one of our local restaurants. Our Booster Club will be serving all day and will donate the proceeds to GHS Speech for medals and plaques honoring the success of our students. The Menu is posted on the webpage.

Third, please help us in the gym commons area by encouraging your students to pick up after themselves at the end of the day.

Fourth, be sure to tell parents to arrive 30 minutes before sons or daughters are to perform. In order to stay on time, some students may have to go out of order. Thirty minutes should be enough leeway. This is a two floor building and except for two exceptions, we have scheduled events according to floor: even number centers are on the second floor; odd numbered centers are on the first floor. Also remind your parents that there will be \$3 *donation* at the door to help offset costs.

We will also have additional bus parking at the middle school which is literally “across the creek” and accessible by a footbridge—about a two and one half minute walk.

If you are a coach who is also judging, the judges’ meeting is at 7:20 in the auditorium.
